

Horse Camp Summary

- 1. Drop off 7am, pick up at 5pm.
- 2. Camp days are Monday Thursday (1st week is Tuesday-Friday)
- 3. If needed to drop off or pick up earlier or later please let us know when you sign your child up.
- 4. At A Place for Dreamers our goal is to give children a time of peace, fun, team building exercises and education of the life of a horse and the people who own them.
- 5. At this camp, each child will be provided water and snacks. Please let us know if your child has any Food Allergies! There are going to be stations that each age group will go to separately so that each child will be able to learn at their knowledge level. Each day there will be a different craft, game and they will do different things with the horses. By the end of this camp they will be able to ride a horse walking by themselves and some may go further when they leave APFD camp with knowledge of horses!
- 6. Please pack your child a lunch, extra pair of clothes, insect repellent, beach towel, medication notification form specifying type of medicine and dosage amount, etc!
